### **The Cadet Must Purchase and HAVE WITH THEM ON DAY 1:**

PT Uniform (2), Cadet Uniform (2), Black T-shirt, Windbreaker, Boots, Duty Belt, Under Belt, Holster, Belt Keepers, Handcuffs and Case, Magazine Case, Flashlight, Semi-Automatic Handgun with at least 3 magazines. **Night sights and weapon light recommended. NOTE: Sig Sauer P320 9mm recommended for female cadets.**  
**DO NOT BRING WEAPON INTO CLASS.**

Required Prior to Academy Start Date: Cadet will provide all documentation required by the Commission (T.C.O.L.E.) stated in the most current Rules Handbook ([www.tcole.tx.state.us](http://www.tcole.tx.state.us)) or (Texas Administrative Code Title 37; Part 7; Chapter 217; Rule 217.1 Minimum Standards for Initial Licensure)

## **DAILY CLASS REQUIREMENTS:**

Cadets will arrive **ON TIME, EVERY DAY**, in uniform of the day, with all study materials, **ALL GEAR** and boots shined.

**CELL PHONES will be secured and available for class breaks and family/work emergencies only.**

Cadets are expected to maintain a level of professionalism and hygiene throughout the academy that is commensurate with the position they seek.

Cadets will conduct themselves appropriately for a classroom environment.

Cadets will remain clean shaven (mustache acceptable no lower than corner of the mouth) throughout the academy.

Cadet's hair (MALE or FEMALE) will NOT touch the collar.

Tattoos are acceptable (No nudity or vulgarity).

Earrings and facial piercings are not acceptable.

Cadets will be taught the chain of command concept and will be expected to maintain it throughout their time in the academy.

Cadets may only miss 14 days total **FOR ANY REASON PER TCOLE.**

Cadets may **NOT MISS ANY DAYS OF THE FOLLOWING COURSES** of instruction: **Standard Field Sobriety Training, Firearms, TASER/OC Spray, Police Driving, ALERRT (Active Shooter).**

Cadets will be expected to make up any missed courses on their own time.
